

Jefferson County Chamber of Commerce Meeting
January 15, 2021

Programs included an update on the COVID vaccine by a representative of Jefferson Healthcare. Currently JH receives periodic shipments of the Pfizer vaccine of 975 doses. Half are administered and the other half is reserved to make sure people are able to receive their second dose. Since December 16th JH has received 3 shipments, plus an additional shipment that only contained dry ice.

Jefferson County has gone against the state mandate on age due to the unusually higher age group of our population. As far as anyone that suffers from underlying conditions; it is too difficult to sort that out, so they are only using the age criteria at this time. Currently they are vaccinating anyone over the age of 85, as they administer to that age group, they will drop down to 80, 75, and so on.

The consultation and the set-ups are all available to any businesses in Jefferson and Clallam County through a 2-year federal grant free of charge.
